FINDINGS

1. Authorization:

D.C. Official Code §2-354.04, 19 DCMR §4320.7

2. Minimum Need:

The District of Columbia Public Library (DCPL) minimum need is to purchase annual maintenance and license for the BMC Footprints Service Desk and Asset Core software.

3. Estimated Fair and Reasonable Price:

\$23,579.00

4. Facts That Justify a Sole Source Procurement:

- A. This software is used to manage, maintain, monitor, and report all IT assets of DCPL. It is also used to report, monitor, track and manage service tickets of DCPL IT, Facilities, and Communications.
- B. BMC Software, Inc. is the developer and sole provider of BMC software and specialized services.
- C. BMC Footprints Service Desk and Asset Core are proprietary software products that are only available from BMC Software, Inc. and BMC Software, Inc. retains the exclusive copyright, trade secret and patent rights to the BMC software.
- D. BMC Software, Inc. has sole knowledge of the development of the software and configuration requirements exclusive to the BMC software.
- E. In consideration of the above, BMC Software, Inc. is the only source able to provide the maintenance and license required by DCPL.
